CARNATION LOAF RECIPE

8 oz Margarine.
8 oz Castor Sugar
1 lb Mixed Fruit
4 ozs Cherries
Small Tin Carnation Milk
2 Eggs
5 oz Self-Raising Flour
5 oz Plain Flour

Cream margarine and sugar. Stir in fruit and eggs with a little flour at a time. Mixture will be quite stiff at this stage. Gradually add milk and rest of flour and mix well. Divide mixture between two 1 lb size loaf tins and bake for 1½- 1¾ hours at 170°C.

Store for two weeks before using.

Only one loaf to be submitted for judging.
